This camp is run by volunteers dedicated to creating a safe and supportive community for youth. Three deans, many Youth Empowered Lay Leaders (YELLers), and the Primary On-Site Adult Leaders (PALs) will be working very hard to plan a great week for everyone that will be safe, engaging and all inclusive. 4-9<sup>th</sup> of July 2011, mark the date!

Throughout the week there will be plenty of exciting and community oriented activities such as workshops, worship, touch-groups and special events. We will also have a joint event with the Middle school Unitarian Universalist Gatherings event at a nearby camp in Mendocino. Each day there will be three meals served either buffet or family style. There will **ALWAYS** be a vegetarian/vegan option. We try to meet every person's dietary needs, given advanced notification.



Campers will be lodged in redwood cabins without electricity. Meals, and most other activities, will take place in and around the dining hall.
